

POLICY ON EQUAL EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY

POLICY STATEMENT

Access to appropriate educational opportunities is the right of every student.

PURPOSE

To provide education which enables students to achieve to the best of their ability regardless of ethnicity, cultural background, social background, gender, religious beliefs, age or geographic location.

GUIDELINES

Subject to the support services available to the school, and to the limitations of staffing ratios and funding, the school has a commitment to the following –

1. To identify those students at risk of not receiving equal educational opportunity for any of the above reasons.
2. To respond to specific needs by assessing available resources and support services if and when the need arises.
3. To monitor and adapt programmes according to student need.
4. To monitor existing and new school resources in accordance with this policy.
5. To provide positive role models in terms of gender, race and disability.
6. To provide professional development for staff where appropriate to support this policy.
