

POLICY ON BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

POLICY STATEMENT

The School recognises that students and teachers have a right to a safe, pleasant working and learning environment. Students need to be responsible for their own actions and to show courtesy and respect for others, for the property of others and for the environment.

The school endeavours to assist students to develop appropriate social skills and modes of personal behaviour and presentation.

PURPOSE

- a. To develop a disciplined environment in which values such as honesty, courtesy and integrity are shared.
- b. To help students to appreciate the rights of others to learn in a safe secure environment.
- c. To help students appreciate the consequences of their actions.

GUIDELINES

1. The school will develop a code of conduct for the classroom that is known, displayed and understood by all students.
2. The school rules and expectations will be printed in the prospectus and diary to ensure that students and parents are aware of the standards expected.
3. Parents will sign a statement on the enrolment card confirming that they have read, understood, and will encourage their daughter to abide by these rules and expectations.
4. The school rules and expectations are applicable during the school day, coming to and going from school, on school trips and at all events organised by the school.
5. Behaviour on buses to and from school is also subject to the rules and expectations.
6. Parents/caregivers, where necessary, will be involved when a child's behaviour is causing concern to enable their co-operation.
7. A set of disciplinary steps will be taken to deal with behaviour that is causing concern.
